The purpose of this letter is to solicit your support to provide Terminal Area Forecasts (TAFs) for the new Plattsburgh International Airport (PBG).

I ask that you consider this letter a formal request by the Plattsburgh International Airport (PBG) for the National Weather Service to provide the airport with TAFs, on a full time basis. The air carrier currently operating at Clinton County Airport (PLB) is scheduled to move to PBG in May of 2007. We request the effective start of the TAF service coincide with that date. The FAA is currently commissioning the ILS precision approach for runway 35. The NWS in support from the FAA will relocate the ASOS to PBG from PLB in the May timeframe also. A NWS TAF at PBG will improve PBG's usability and safety.
